



THE VOLLEYBALL LINEUP CARD

Roster and Lineup (*Rule 7-1*)

10 minutes prior to the end of the pre-match timed warm-up, a coach from each team shall submit in writing to the scorer an accurate roster giving names and uniform numbers of all players for the match.

2 minutes prior to the end of the pre-match timed warm-up, a coach from each team shall submit to the scorer an accurate, written lineup of the uniform numbers for the six starting players in serve order.

Only one Libero may be designated per set and must be designated on the lineup sheet prior to each set. If none marked, ask the coach (preventative officiating).

The R2 will verify that the lineup has been entered correctly on the official score sheet.

No later than two minutes following each set, a coach from each team shall submit a written, accurate numeric lineup to the scorer.

The written roster and current lineup shall remain at the officials table throughout each set.

LINEUP CARD (*SEE NFHS VOLLEYBALL CASE BOOK*)

The lineup card is a required tool to assist the R2 in carrying out their duties. The lineup card is to be used to record the starting lineup and verify each team's lineup at the start of the set. The

R2 must place players on lineup card by starting floor position and not serve order.

Information to be kept on the lineup card may include:

- Correct serving order
- Captains
- Correct server
- Substitutions
- Time-outs
- Player identification

Each official will determine which form or style of lineup card he/she will use. Whatever style is easiest and most effective shall be used.
